Carrying several interesting books, the book seller touts and advertises his books for **read**ers in the neighborhood.

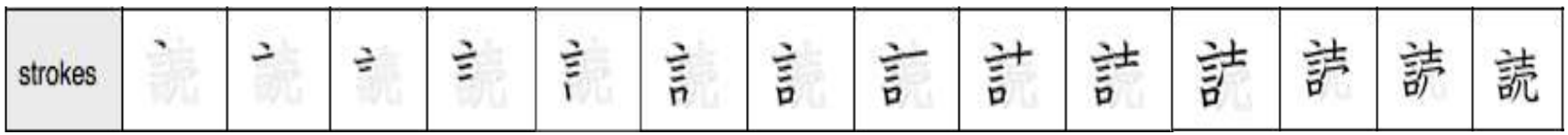

よむ 読	Yomu よむ	To read	毎日電車の中で新聞を 読み ます。 (Mainichi densha no naka de shinbun o yomimasu .)	Everyday I read newspaper in the train.
どくしょ 読書	Dokusho どくしょ	Reading	彼女は2時間 読書 をしていた。 (Kanojo wa 2 jikan dokusho o shite ita.)	She had been reading for two hours.
どくしゃ 読者	Dokusha どくしゃ	Reader	あの雑誌は普通の 読者 向けです。 (Ano zasshi wa futsuu no dokusha muke desu.)	That magazine is suitable for general readers .





Writing Hand (書) + Sun/Day (日) = 書
 Good hand-writing is possible when you **write** in light.
 (Write → Hand, using brush in light.)



Is your room dim or light? **Ca**use one can be **cu**rious about good hand-writing conditions. Preferred environment should be light to **show** and make it clear what/how you exactly write/draw.
 (To remember its readings **KAKU** and **SHO**.)



USED EXAMPLES	READING	MEANING	IN SENTENCE	REMARKS
かく 書く	Kaku かく	To write	ここに名前を書いてください。 (Koko ni namae o kaite kudasai.)	Please, write your name here.
しよてん 書店	Shoten しよてん	Book shop	私は1か月に2回その書店に行く。 (Watashi wa ikkagetsu ni 2 kai sono shoten ni iku.)	I go to that book store 2 times a month.
ぶんしよ 文書	Bunsho ぶんしよ	Sentence	下線部分に注意して、この文書を読んでください。 (Kasen bubun ni chuui shite, kono bunsho o yonde kudasai.)	Please read the sentence and pay particular attention to the underlined part.
ひしよ 秘書	Hisho ひしよ	Secretary	昨日、秘書にこの手紙をタイプさせた。 (Kinou, hisho ni kono tegami o taypu saseta.)	Yesterday, I had my secretary type this letter.
